Overview

Evidence-based practice has been shown to reduce the time in which research takes to reach the bedside. This conference will include both podium and poster presentations designed to showcase actual examples of integrating evidence-based decision-making into daily clinical practice. Presentations will include a summary of the high-quality evidence used to make a recommendation for a change in practice, and how the change was implemented and measured.
