

## Health & Safety Guidelines for In-person MSK CME Activities

The MSK CME team recognizes that the COVID-19 situation is fluid. We will continue monitoring key indicators and adjust our policies as needed to ensure the safety of our community. We will continue to update this page as new guidance is released. Your health and safety, and that of our patients and employees, is our highest priority at MSK CME activities.

### In-person Attendees

**All in person attendees and faculty at MSK CME activities must be fully vaccinated\* against COVID-19 two weeks before the event.** By attending MSK CME activities in person, you are confirming that you:

- Are fully vaccinated\*
- Are not experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention at CDC.gov
- Acknowledge and will abide by MSK's PPE and social distancing policies and applicable health and safety protocols

(\*A person is considered fully vaccinated two weeks after receiving the single-dose Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccine or two weeks after receiving the second dose of either the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines. In the context of our vendor and visitor policy, a person is considered unvaccinated if they do not meet the above criteria.)

### Proof of Vaccination

- **External Guests:** Copy of Vaccine Card(s) (documentation must show both doses) must be submitted to MSK CME 72 hours before coming to our facilities.
- **MSK Employees:** COVID-19 Badge Sticker on MSK ID Card.

### MSK's PPE and Social Distancing Policies

Wearing a mask is optional, though highly encouraged, for in person attendees and faculty while at **Rockefeller Research Laboratory** and **Zuckerman Research Center**. Masks are required at all times at MSK's clinical buildings in areas where patients may be present, regardless of vaccination status (Ex. 1275 York Ave/Main Campus). Food and beverages are allowed at in-person meetings in designated areas. Conference room occupancy limits are currently at 75% max capacity. Attendees should socially distance themselves to the extent possible when attending MSK CME activities.

### Compliance with MSK Policies

By choosing to attend any in-person component of a MSK CME activity, you agree to comply with all safety protocols MSK and/or the Event Venue may have in place. To preserve a safe environment, any attendees who fails to comply with MSK protocols may be denied entrance to the Event or removed the Event. Any attendee who is denied access/entrance to or removed from an Event based on this policy will not be eligible for a refund of any registration fees paid for access/entrance to or participation in the Event.
