- 1. All financial relationships have been provided within the last 24 months with an ineligible company. I am aware that these will be reviewed, mitigated, and disclosed to learners as needed.
- 2. All recommendations for patient care are based on current science, evidence, and clinical reasoning. while giving a fair and balanced view of diagnostic and therapeutic options.
- 3. All scientific research referred to, reported, or used in this educational activity in support or justification of a patient care recommendation conforms to the generally accepted standards of experimental design, data collection, analysis, and interpretation.
- 4. New and evolving topics for which there is a lower (or absent) evidence base, should be clearly identified as such within the education and individual presentations. Content does not advocate for, or promote, practices that are not, or not yet, adequately based on current science, evidence, and clinical reasoning.
- 5. I will exclude any advocacy for, or promotion of, unscientific approaches to diagnosis or therapy, or recommendations, treatment, or manners of practicing healthcare that are determined to have risks or dangers that outweigh the benefits or are known to be ineffective in the treatment of patients.
- 6. If I am discussing any product use that is off label, I will disclose that the use or indication in question is not currently approved by the FDA.
- 7. I have not and will not accept any honoraria, additional payments, or reimbursements directly from an ineligible company for my participation in this activity.
- 8. I understand that educational content/presentation will need to be provided and reviewed prior to a CE activity, and I will provide these in advance as requested.
- 9. I will not promote, market, or sell products or services of an ineligible company, or for my own professional or financial interests. I will not include corporate and product logos, trade names, or product group messaging.
- 10. If I am discussing specific healthcare products or services, I will use generic names to the extent possible. If I need to use trade names, I will use trade names from multiple companies when available, and not a trade name from a single company.
- 11. If I have been trained or utilized by an ineligible company or its agent as a speaker (e.g. speaker's bureau), my educational content/presentation will not include any promotional aspects of that
- 12. If I am presenting research funded by an ineligible company, the information presented will be based on generally accepted scientific principles and methods and will not promote the interest of the ineligible company.
- 13. If I am discussing patient information, I will ensure that protected health information (PHI) is not presented. If needed for clinical educational purposes, I have obtained signed HIPAA authorization and any other required consents from the individuals whose PHI is included.
